- I. Welcome and Call to Order**
- a. Megan Nussbaum, President, called the meeting to order at 5:40pm.

- II. OSU Alumni Association Report (Craig Little)**
- a. No report.
- III. Newsletter – Dr. Wilson**
- a. Fall Alumni Event/ Bucks Brunch/BBQ ‘n Brew (BBnB)
    - i. In the newsletter we were unable to state which game we have because we do not yet have the official word from the Alumni Association.
    - ii. Dr. Wilson changed the newsletter accordingly.

    - i. There are 4 sponsors on the front cover.
      - 1. Total donations from sponsors = \$500
